





## Reception Homework Grid

This half-term Reception are trying out a new Homework scheme, instead of getting homework each week based on Literacy or Maths, the children can choose one section of the grid to complete each week. There are only six weeks this half-term so you choose which six to complete!

<p>Can you think about the technologies you know about? This can be at home or school.</p> <p>You could draw/write about the technologies you know about.</p> 	<p>Practise writing the letters we have been practising: m, a, d, s, t, i, n, g, p and o.</p> <p>We are working with single letters and making simple words e.g. mad. If you want to write more words or a sentence, go ahead!</p>	<p>Can you complete some addition sums? For example <math>3 + 6</math>.</p> <p>We are working with numbers below 20, you can always challenge yourself to go higher!</p>
<p>Draw someone who helps you.</p> <p>Our topic is 'People who help us', you can draw/write/make something related to someone who helps you.</p>	<p><b><u>Homework free pass!</u></b></p> <p>You can have a week free of homework, just write this in your homework book for Miss Newhouse to see.</p>	<p>Can you complete some subtraction sums? We are working with numbers below 20, you can always challenge yourself to go higher!</p> $10 - 6 =$
<p>Do you know any times?</p> <p>Have a think about what time you get up on a morning and what time you go to bed?</p> <p>You can draw/make/write about this.</p>	<p>In Reception we are thinking about our routines. Can you talk to your child about a routine they might have e.g. on Sunday's they might go to the park or to see a family member.</p>	<p>Do you recognise any coins?</p> <p>You could draw/help your parents use coins to pay for items.</p> 

We do understand in Reception the children are beginning to write, so parents can write for the children at this stage. Although, try to encourage your child to write first, even if it's just one letter or they could copy your writing to improve their skills. At this point in the year we are expecting the children to write simple three letter words.

I have given some suggestions e.g. draw/write, however, it is up to you and your child how you demonstrate their learning through the homework challenges.
