Year 1	<p>What was the impact of George Stephenson in Darlington?</p> <p>George Stephenson was a British civil engineer and created railroads from Stockton to Darlington. Class 1 are going to learn and explore how he created the locomotive and how his important legacy still continues today.</p>
Year 2	<p>Was London better before or after The Great Fire?</p> <p>An accidental fire turned into a significant event in British History. The fire burnt far and wide for four days. Where were the firefighters? Could another Great Fire happen today? We will find out the answers over the next few weeks...</p>
Year 3	<p>Would you prefer to live in prehistoric Britain or Britain today?</p> <p>We are going to investigate into how people during the Stone age era survived without shops, heating, technology and other key resources that we use to survive in our own day to day lives in the 21st century.</p>
