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Dear Parents / Guardians,

This is our final letter of the academic year! What another surreal year! Hopefully, this is the last year that we will have to work in bubbles and have periods of self-isolation. We understand how much of an inconvenience it is to get a call telling you your child needs to isolate, especially if you then have to take unpaid leave. We have had it with our own staff, they too have had to take unpaid leave if they have isolated with their own children.

This letter includes two important points for September:

1. The restructure which will take place from September.
2. Your child's new class teacher.

### **Restructure**

You may or may not be aware that the expertise of some of our staff at Red Hall has led to other schools from up and down the country asking for us to support them / arranging visits to the school, to see how we do it here. This is a fantastic opportunity as 'Our Little Red Hall' is really shining within Darlington and beyond! This, along with the Local Authority provision we now have, as part of Red Hall, has led to us restructuring how the school is currently led.

From September, some changes will take place. This will not impact negatively on the school in any way, instead, it will strengthen Red Hall further. All staff will still be in school, there has simply been a restructure of some roles. This means, the day to day running of the school will now be with Miss Snowdon. Ms Davidson will always be available; however, her role will be as the lead responsible for both the direction and leadership of the provision and the main school as well as support for others in Darlington and beyond.

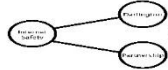
