(Just a reminder, EYFS stands for Early Years Foundation Stage and this includes 2Year Olds, Nursery and Reception, KS1 – Key Stage 1 and includes Year 1 and Year 2, KS2 – Key Stage 2 – Years 3, 4, 5 and 6.)

Online safety

Before the summer holidays, we had a number of online safety incidents. We are pleased to say these have reduced and there have been only a handful online safety concerns, since September. Thank you to all parents and carers for your support with this.

Staffing

- Mrs Bashford made the decision just before the Summer Holidays to leave being a teacher altogether. We are very sad to see her go and we wish her lots of luck for the future, with whatever she decides to do. Her last working day with us, will be Friday 11th November.
- We have employed a teacher to take on the Year 1 class, called Miss Rafferty. The children in Year 1 were part of the interview process, so they have met her before. She will begin on Monday 7th November, and work with Mrs Bashford and the Year 1 class throughout that week, before taking on the class fully, the week after.
- Miss Evans in EYFS left us last week, as she completed her apprenticeship with us. We thank her for all she did for the children in our EYFS provision.
- Mrs Morfoot had her baby!! On Friday 23rd September, as we were all getting ready for school, Mrs Morfoot gave birth to her healthy baby boy Theo. Both mum and baby are doing great.
- Miss Ward has joined us as a TA apprentice in Early Years.

You may have realised that Red Hall staffing has hit a bit of a baby boom! With Miss Johnston having her baby girl (Edie) in May, Mrs Morfoot giving birth to Theo in September... Then... Miss Snowdon is due to leave on maternity leave from the middle of November, ANDDDD Miss Egglestone is leaving us at Christmas to have her baby. Miss Johnston is due back in January, so she will take on our Reception class, this will be a huge change for her, but we know she will do an amazing job!

Due to our Head of School (Miss Snowdon) and Assistant Headteacher (Miss Egglestone) both being on maternity leave at the same time, Miss Henry has been asked to be "Acting Head of School" until Miss Snowdon's return in May time.



Attendance

- Attendance continues to be a focus for our school this year, as with many other schools in the country. Results are showcased on our Facebook page for parents to see and classes are rewarded with ice lollies, hot chocolates and other treats, if they win class attendance.
- We understand completely this term and next half term are always tricky with attendance, as the children are back in school after a long Summer off, and then as the weather gets colder, children (and staff!!) pick up bugs, coughs, colds etc. If you know your child is NOT well and they have something contagious, then please do keep them off. If you believe they can come to school, then please send them in. We promise to send them home to you, should they be struggling in school.
- Holidays we have had a number of families who have taken children on holiday during this half term whilst we completely understand the HUGE difference in cost from term time to school holidays, we do still need to follow Darlington Local Authority procedures with fines etc, as we are a Local Authority school. We hope you understand this.

We have had some concerns passed to us, by parents this half term, which is brilliant that these are being shared; it would be even better if you could phone these through and log these directly with this team.
