### Uniform

Walking through our school today, my heart has been completely full seeing every single child looking absolutely gorgeous in their uniforms.

Just a reminder to you all that from September we moved to our Active Uniform here at Red Hall. Our teachers just love to be able to take the children outside, whatever the weather and get them moving around in their learning. Wearing these uniform means children are comfortable and ready for whatever is planned each day.

This consists of:

- **A red sweatshirt or hoody (overhead or zipped).**
- **A white polo shirt (not t-shirt).**
- **Plain black jogging bottoms or leggings (these must be all black, no stripes or tracksuit designs).**
- **ALL black or ALL white trainers.**
- **And in the warmer weather, children can wear black shorts or skorts.**

PLEASE make sure every single item of clothing is clearly labelled with your child's name. This simple step makes such a difference when we're trying to reunite lost jumpers and cardigans with their rightful owners! ### **Outdoor Play and Learning**

As you know, we absolutely pride ourselves on the incredible outdoor opportunities we provide for our children - those precious moments where they can simply be children, exploring and playing freely. For this to happen safely, your child absolutely **MUST** have wellies in school, along with a waterproof coat and a complete change of clothes in their bags for those wet and muddy activities. Without these essentials, we simply cannot allow children to venture onto the field or into our wonderful woodland areas where they might get wet or muddy.

If your child has waterproofs at home, they can also be brought into school. Although we try to make sure we can supply children with these ourselves, if they want to wear their own to cover all their uniforms during outdoor play then please also send these in.

I understand the weather has been beautifully warm, and you might not feel these items are necessary just yet, but we need them in school ready for when the weather inevitably changes. Please ensure your child comes equipped with everything they need.
